Johnson, U.S. Grant, Hayes, Garfield, C. A. Arthur, Grover Cleveland, B. Harrison, McKinley, and T. Roosevelt.*

Director of Examination:

ANDREW JACKSON

Description: Ink signature, "Andrew Jackson," in the hand of the president, on a vellum 6 x 1" slip clipped from a document.

MARTIN VAN BUREN

Description: Ink signature, "M V Buren," in the hand of Buren, on a 2 x .75" slip clipped from a letter.

WILLIAM HENRY HARRISON

Description: Exceedingly rare partially clipped ANS, 2.5 x 4.5", dated 29 July 1795, Greeneville [sic], reading *The Commissary will issue for the Potawatomies forty five pounds of beef and flour-*, signed in the hand of Harrison "Wm. H. Harrison, A.d.C." This note was penned just four days before the signing of the Treaty of Greenville, which ended the Northwest Indian War and granted American settlers access to formerly Indian-held lands in Ohio, Michigan, Indiana, and Illinois. The Potawatomies were one of several tribes fighting together as the Western Confederacy.

JOHN TYLER

Description: Ink signature, "J. Tyler," in the hand of the president, on an off-white 2 x .75" slip clipped from a letter.

JAMES K. POLK

Description: Scarce ink signature, "James K. Polk," in the hand of the president, on an off-white 1 x 3.5" slip clipped from a letter.

ZACHARY TAYLOR

Description: Ink signature, in the hand of Taylor, "Z. Taylor, Col. Cmg," on an off-white 1.5 x 3.5" slip clipped from document.

MILLARD FILLMORE

Description: Ink signature, in the hand of Fillmore, "Millard Fillmore," on an off-white .75 x 3.5" slip clipped from a letter.

FRANKLIN PIERCE

Description: Large ink signature, "Franklin Pierce," in the hand of the president, on an off-white 6.25 x 2.25" slip clipped from a document, also signed by his Secretary of State W. L. Marcy and one other.

JAMES BUCHANAN

Description: Ink signature, "James Buchanan," in the hand of the president, on an off-white 4 x 1" slip clipped from a letter.

ANDREW JOHNSON

Description: Ink signature, "Andrew Johnson, 31st July 1868," in the hand of the president, on an off-white 4 x 2.5" portion of a clipped document.

ULYSSES S. GRANT

Description: Ink signature, "U.S. Grant," in the hand of the president, on an off-white 3 x 2.5" calling card.

RUTHERFORD B. HAYES

Description: Ink signature, "Rutherford B. Hayes," in the hand of Hayes, on an off-white 3 x 1" slip clipped from a calling card.

JAMES A. GARFIELD

Description: Ink signature, "J.A. Garfield, Hiram, Ohio," in the hand of Garfield, on an off-white 4.75 x 3 sheet.

CHESTER A. ARTHUR

Description: Ink signature, "C. A. Arthur, New York" in the hand of Arthur, on an off-white 4.25 x 2.5" sheet.

GROVER CLEVELAND (Representing the 22nd and 24th Presidencies)

Description: Ink signature, "Grover Cleveland," in the hand of Cleveland, on an off-white 2.5 x 1.5" calling card.

BENJAMIN HARRISON

Description: Ink signature, "Benja. Harrison, Indiana," in the hand of Harrison, on an off-white 5 x 2" sheet.

WILLIAM MCKINLEY

Description: Ink signature, "Wm McKinley, Jr.," in the hand of McKinley, on an off-white 4 x 1.5" slip clipped from a letter.

THEODORE ROOSEVELT

Description: Ink signature, "Theodore Roosevelt," in the hand of the president, on an official White House Presidential calling card clipped to 3.5 x 2".
