- **Featuring an original 10 x 12" (25x30 cm) stunning vintage photograph of Albert Einstein by famed photographer Philippe Halsman, New Jersey, 1947.**
- In 1947, Halsman made what was to become one of his most famous photos of a mournful Albert Einstein, who during the photography session recounted his regrets about his role in the United States pursuing the atomic bomb. The photo would later be used in 1966 on a U.S. postage stamp and in 1999, on the cover of Time, when Time dubbed Einstein as 'Person of the Century.'
- Preserved and seal mounted in 1960 to acid free photography board.
