This classic image, from one of Milton & Marilyn's most recognized collaborations, was taken at Milton's New York City studio. Clothing designer, Ann Klein, sent various outfits for Marilyn to wear, however all the outfits were 2 sizes too small. Consequently, all of the poses in this sitting amusingly deal with Marilyn's problem of holding up the ill-fitting satin dress.
